



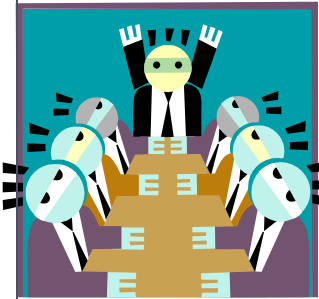

## Home Repair Tip of the month

### Measuring Windows

Step 1 - Measure the width of the window first. Measure across the window at the top; then across the middle and the bottom. These measurements may not be the same, so you will use the smallest of them.

Step2 - Measure the height next. Measure on the left, then in the middle, and then on the right. Use the largest of these.

Step 3 - Measure the depth of the window, from the window itself to the outside of the frame. Do this on the left, the right, the top and the bottom. They should all be the same, but in the event the measurements are different, use the smallest.

## Re-Store News

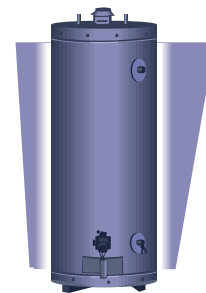
### Re-Store Hours
