### How to Hang an Interior Door

- Trim the Door to Fit
- Mark the Hardware Location
- Chisel out the hinge mortises
- Drill for a mortise lockset
- Drill for the cylinder lockset
- Locate the spindle hole
- Hang the door and attach the hardware
